Eligibility:

1. Must hold an undergraduate degree from a recognized university.
 2. Be enrolled in a full-time postgraduate degree program at a recognized university in a master's or higher degree.
 3. Child, or grandchild of a member of the Highland Society of New Brunswick at Miramichi in good standing.
 4. Submit a completed application by July 21, 2026, to the Highland Society of New Brunswick at Miramichi, Box 303 Miramichi, NB, E1N 3A7
- A personal interview may be required.

Before mailing your application, please be sure to ✓ that you have included the following:

- 1. Your Application
- 2. The Letter of acceptance for postgraduate study from a recognized university.
- 3. An Official Transcript of your marks from the university where your undergraduate degree was granted.
- 4. A letter stating (750-1000+ words in length):
 - a. Your personal goals
 - b. Your financial need
 - c. Your involvement/volunteerism in community
 - d. Your future plans.
- 5. Two (2) letters of reference: dated (current with the year of application), signed by referee.
